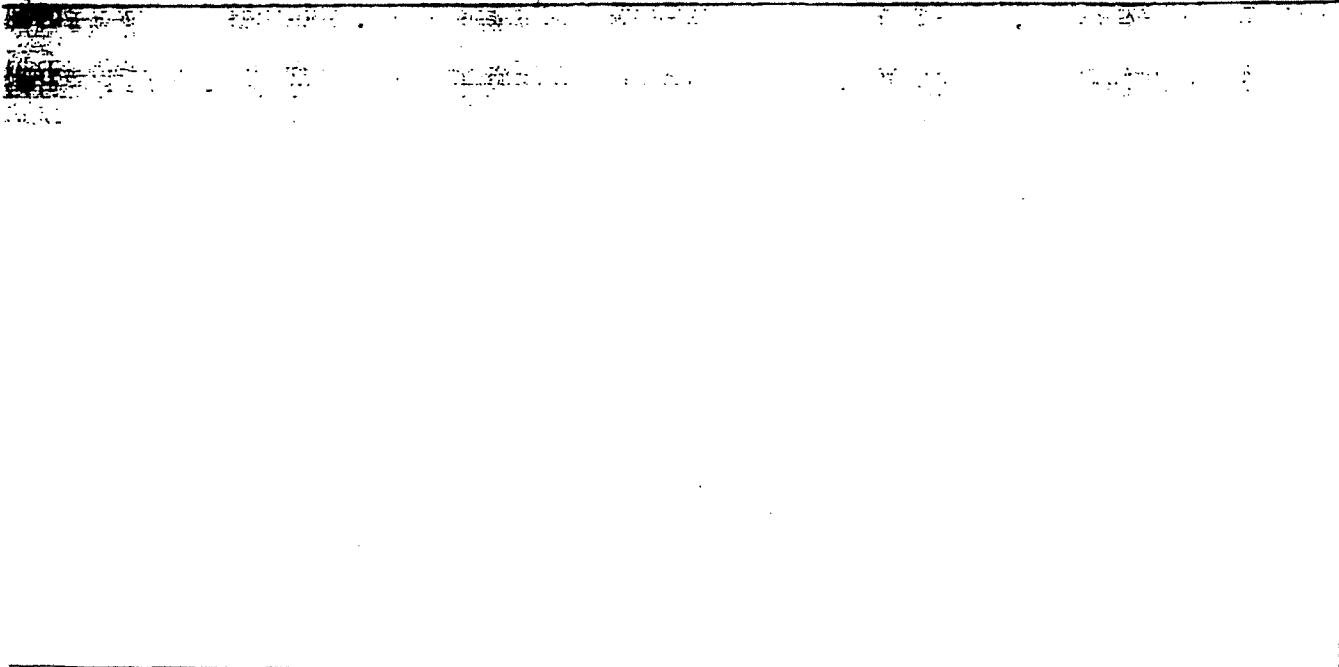

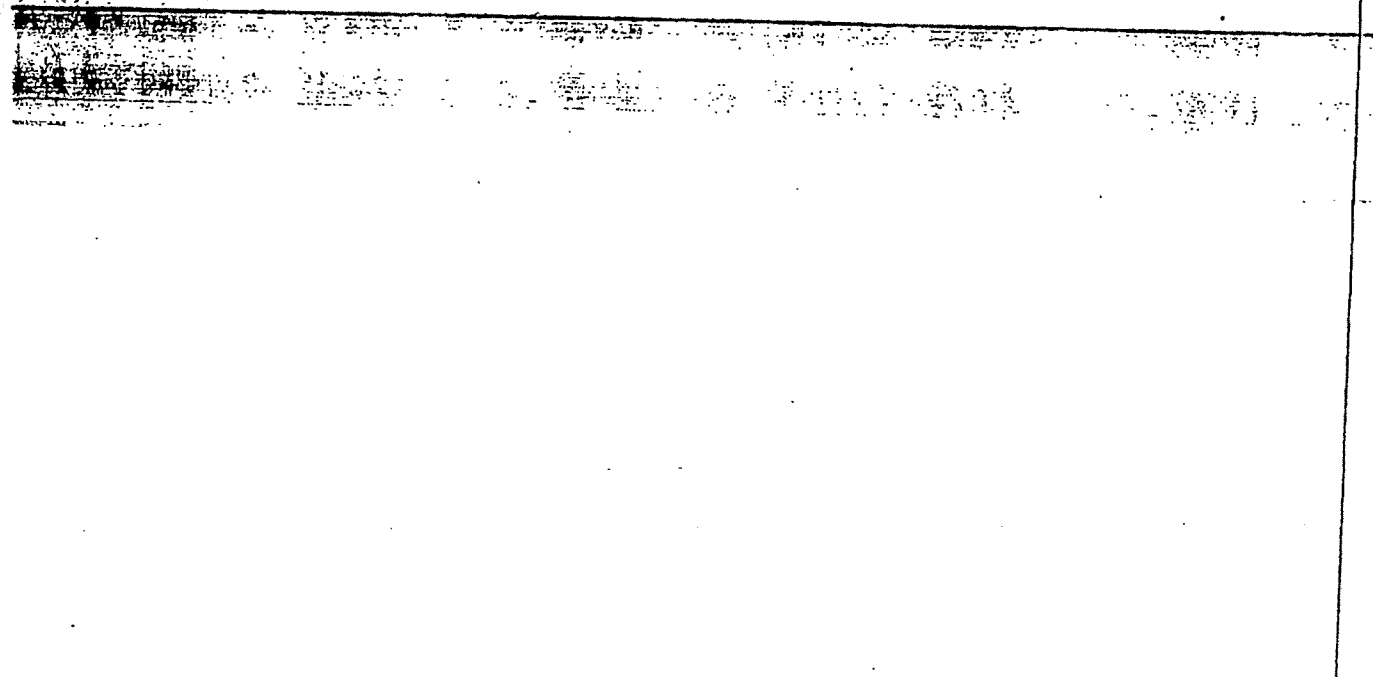



2. He has been in custody for 9 months. He said he knows he made a mistake, but he wants to go to work so he can pay child support.
3. He wants to change his life and be a better husband and father.
4. He says he has learned his lesson.


Summary:

Due to the defendant's age, a check of his juvenile record was not pursued. His Adult Record began in 1983 with a Public Intoxication charge (583-6813). During the ensuing 25 years he has accrued 6 felony convictions with 2 Petitions to Revoke probation and an FTA plus his pending case. He has 2 weapons convictions, 9 convictions for Battery, and 6 drug convictions with one Petition to Revoke probation, not including the 5 pending drug charges in the Present Offense. His extensive criminal history appears to constitute an ideation toward criminal activity which would not be addressed by release from custody or bond modification.

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



ERICLOGAN, upon his oath, says

My full true name is ERIK JACK LOGAN, and I request that all proceedings against me be had in the name which I declare to be my true name.

I have attended school and completed 12 years of education and I have the ability to read, write and speak the English language.

I am represented by counsel and my lawyer's name is Anthony Luber.

I have received a copy of the Information before being called upon to plea and have read and discussed it with my lawyer and believe and feel that I understand every accusation made against me in this case.

I have told my lawyer the facts and surrounding circumstances as know to me concerning the matters mentioned in the Information and believe and feel that my lawyer is fully informed as to all such matters. My lawyer has since informed me and has counseled and advised with me, as to the nature and cause of every accusation against me and as to the possible defenses I might have in this case.

I understand that I am entitled to have all of my rights which may be involved in this matter explained to me, and that I have the right to have any questions I may have answered to me.

I understand that I may, if so chosen, plead NOT GUILTY, to any charge against me and that if I choose to plead NOT GUILTY, the Constitution guarantees me:

- a. the right to a speedy and public trial by jury in the St. Joseph

Superior Court, St. Joseph County, State of Indiana at which the jury will be instructed that they must presume me innocent unless the evidence overcomes that presumption;

- b. the right to be released on reasonable bail until my trial occurs;
- c. the right to face the witnesses against me;
- d. the right to use the power and process of the Court to compel the production of any evidence, including the attendance of any witnesses in my favor at my trial;
- e. the right to assistance of Counsel at every stage of the proceedings including upon an appeal if need be, with the appointment of such counsel being at no cost to me if I am found to be indigent by the Court;
- f. the right to require the State to prove to the jury unanimously my guilt beyond a reasonable doubt by evidence at a trial at which I may not be compelled to testify against myself, but at which I may testify if I choose to;
- g. the right, in the event that I should be found guilty of the charge against me, to appeal my conviction on such a charge to a higher court.

Notwithstanding the above, I have, with the assistance of Counsel, entered into the following agreement with the State of Indiana:


1. The defendant, Eric Logan, will be allowed to withdraw his plea of Not Guilty and enter a plea of Guilty to Counts I, III and V, Dealing in Cocaine, Class A Felonies, under I.C. 35-48-4-1,

3. The defendant will receive and serve a sentence of twenty-eight (28) years in the Indiana Department of Correction,
4. Community Corrections shall not be an option for any portion of the sentence,

6. The defendant agrees to forfeit items seized by the police at the time of his arrest.


